Overview

UnCommons, a first-of-its-kind mixed-use development in southwest Las Vegas across from the new Durango Casino & Resort, is reshaping the urban landscape with its innovative approach to workplace design and focus on community. The \$850 million project comprises more than 500,000 square feet of state-of-the-art office space, 830+ residential units upon completion and The Assembly, a next-gen, 5,000-square-foot conference and event pavilion. The walkable 40-acre campus celebrates local and regional culinary talent, cultivating a vibrant dining scene through trendsetting restaurants including all'Antico Vinaio; AMARI Italian Kitchen & Wine Shop; General Admission; Salt & Straw; SunLife Organics; Teaspoon; Todo Bien; Urth Caffé; Blue Bottle Coffee and Wineaux, plus more to open this year. Complemented by local lifestyle brands including Speakeasy Candle Co., Capelli Salon and Drybar in addition to fitness venues such as The Good Place, UnCommons offers a dynamic environment that fosters creativity, collaboration and well-being. Since 1991, the Mazzanti family has been passionately running the three Florence locations of all'Antico Vinaio, drawing crowds of both Italians and tourists. Made with exceptional ingredients and freshly baked Tuscan

schacciata bread, All'Antico Vinaio is “home of the world’s best sandwiches,” according to Saveur magazine. All'Antico Vinaio, which translates to ‘at the ancient wine merchant’s,’ was introduced to the United States by Tommy Mazzanti and revered restaurateur, Joe Bastianich. Serving the same ingredients and freshly baked bread as the original, UnCommons will be home to the third all'Antico Vinaio in the United States and the first outside of New York City.

 - A neighborhood Italian restaurant and wine shop, AMARI offers classic Italian American cuisine, including hand-crafted pasta, pizzas, and more. The restaurant, which earned Wine Spectator's 2024 Award of Excellence, features a market at the front where guests can purchase a bottle of wine to enjoy in the restaurant, in the quad, or to take home. AMARI opened at UnCommons in August 2023.

Blue Bottle opened at UnCommons in March 2025.

It will feature 180 seats throughout its chic dining, bar, lounge and patio spaces and will feature more than 30 televisions throughout the venue ranging from 55-inch to 98-inch, a 40-foot-long bar. General Admission opened at UnCommons in January 2024.

Each location, which now includes four in California and one in Washington, boasts the sights and smells of premium cuts grilled over American red oak, invoking the lore of Rat Pack gatherings and raucous Sinatra dinner parties. Rare Society will open at UnCommons in May 2025.
